ABOUT

La Trobe has more than 33,000 students and seven campuses in Albury-Wodonga, Mildura, Sydney, Melbourne (Bundoora), Melbourne (City), Bendigo and Shepparton. In 2016, we were ranked in the QS Top 50 under 50 for the first time, and 56 in the 2017 *Times Higher Education* 200 Under 50 Rankings. We are also in the world's top 400 universities in all three major ranking agencies: QS World University Rankings 2016–2017, *Times Higher Education* (THE) World University Rankings 2016–2017 and the Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU) 2016.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

The basic admission qualification for postgraduate courses is completion of a recognised Bachelor degree. Other admission requirements vary depending on the course you are interested in. A combination of previous study and relevant work experience will be considered for some courses.

Overseas qualifications and English proficiency

If you hold overseas qualifications from countries where English is not the standard language of instruction, you must provide evidence of English language proficiency. TYPES OF PROGRAMS AVAILABLE

La Trobe University offers a wide range of coursework programs at postgraduate level – Masters, Graduate Diploma and Graduate Certificate.

Most La Trobe University postgraduate coursework programs offered through UAC are fee-paying. Some Commonwealth-supported places (CSPs) are available in some courses in the School of Education and School of Health Sciences.

ENROLMENT

Acceptance of offer

Successful applicants will have their enrolment information emailed.

Advanced standing/Academic credit

Students seeking status/exemption on the basis of studies completed at another institution must complete an 'Application for advanced standing' form (available at latrobe.edu.au/policy/documents/advanced-standing-and-credit-transfer-procedure.pdf) and provide an official transcript of the studies undertaken elsewhere, together with an extract of the course and unit descriptions from the relevant faculty handbook or equivalent. This form should be submitted as soon as possible after a place is offered.

Deferral of offer

It may be possible to postpone your commencement of a postgraduate program after you have received an offer. Deferral requests will be handled directly by La Trobe University. Apply through the deferral section in the online enrolment process at latrobe.edu.au/students/new-students/enrol/accept.
