- Some institutions encourage applicants who don't have educational qualifications to sit STAT as an alternative way of qualifying for admission to tertiary study. You may need to complete additional selection requirements. Check with the relevant institution.

Length of time STAT results remain valid

- 1 10-year validity These institutions will accept STAT results obtained after 2006 for 2017 admissions.
- 2 3-year validity These institutions will accept STAT results obtained after 2013 for 2017 admissions.
- 3 2-year validity These institutions will accept STAT results obtained after 2014 for 2017 admissions.

All other institutions listed above do not have a restriction on the length of time STAT results remain valid.
