ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

There are no minimum academic entry requirements for courses at ANCB.

Students who are under the age of 18 at course commencement will require an interview to assess their suitability for the course and entry will be at the discretion of the HAS.

It is compulsory that all on-campus and online students have access to a computer with fast internet access as well as access to video recording facilities.

Australian secondary studies

If you are a 2016 Australian Year 12 student you do not require an ATAR for entry into ANCB courses.

Australian tertiary studies

Applicants who have attempted previous tertiary studies will be considered for admission on the basis of their overall academic merits.

Overseas qualifications

Australian citizens or permanent residents of Australia with overseas qualifications must contact ANCB to discuss eligibility for admission before submitting an application to UAC.

If you have secondary or tertiary qualifications from countries where English is not the standard language of instruction, you must provide evidence of English language proficiency. Read section 2.9 in Part 1 or visit www.uac.edu.au/undergraduate/admission/elp.shtml for further information.

A minimum English language proficiency of IELTS 5.5 (Academic) equivalent, with a minimum of 5.0 in each skill, is required for entry into ANCB courses.

Alternative entry and pathways

Applicants under 18 years of age

Students who are under the age of 18 at course commencement will be required to attend an interview to assess their suitability for the course and entry will be at the discretion of the Head of Academic Services.

EDUCATIONAL ACCESS SCHEMES
