FEES AND CHARGES

Tuition fees are payable per semester. Fees for each year are published on the AFTRS website aftrs.edu.au. AFTRS reserves the right to change the fees for any course and to make alterations to the course of study, which may increase the fees over the duration of the course.

AFTRS is an approved Higher Education Provider and is registered with Tertiary Education Quality and Standards Agency, which means eligible AFTRS students have the opportunity to apply for the Australian Government's FEE-HELP loan scheme – see 'Financial assistance' below.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE
