ENROLMENT

FEES AND CHARGES

Commonwealth-supported places (CSPs) are available for undergraduate nursing and education/teaching courses, to eligible Australian or New Zealand citizens or permanent humanitarian visa holders.

The B Business is available as a full-fee paying course only. Students can apply for FEE-HELP. Read financial assistance below.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

Eligible CSP students will have access to the HECS-HELP loan scheme.

ACCOMMODATION

You will have the option to reside in dormitories conveniently located on both our Lake Macquarie and Sydney campuses. On-campus living provides a supportive environment where your academic and social journey is shared with friends from all parts of the world. Avondale's staff and students together form a strong community. It also means that you can enjoy the convenience of being just a few minutes' walk from your room to classes, a vegetarian cafeteria, a commercial gym, sporting facilities or organised activities.

Avondale nursing students study at the Clinical Education Centre in state-of-the-art facilities on the grounds of the Sydney Adventist Hospital at Wahroonga, and have the option to study their first year on the Lake Macquarie campus.

STUDENT AND CAMPUS SERVICES
