Industry placements

There are two six-month placements in the undergraduate programs. Placements can be taken in Australia or abroad and this ensures that our graduates are well prepared for roles in the hospitality industry.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

All applicants to the undergraduate programs must:

- have completed an Australian Year 12 or equivalent (if 12 years of education have not been completed, applicants must have completed Year 11 or equivalent and at least a Certificate IV qualification; a partially completed university degree may also be considered)
- be at least 17 years and 9 months of age
- provide original certified copies of any academic and professional qualifications (including the original language and translated document if applicable)
- demonstrate a minimum level of English language competency of IELTS 6.5 (General) or 6.0 (Academic) or equivalent if their first language is not English
- attend an interview.

FEES AND CHARGES

All students must pay the tuition fee for the course – read the course descriptions or visit www.bluemountains.edu.au/apply/fees.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

Students can apply for FEE-HELP, a loan scheme that helps eligible students pay their tuition fees. The Australian Government pays the amount of the loan directly to the student's higher education provider, in this case, BMIHMS. Students then repay their loan through the Australian taxation system once their income rises above the minimum threshold for compulsory repayment. ACCOMMODATION

Leura campus (residential campus)

Accommodation is twin-share in hotel-style rooms with private bathroom, serviced weekly. Rooms typically include desks, shelf space, wardrobe, telephone, 24/7 wireless internet and a small fridge.

Sydney campus (non-residential campus)

Staff can assist with accommodation close to campus, subject to availability, with other students. These newly furnished three- and four-single bedroom apartments are just a short bus ride, or walk, from campus, and linen, crockery, cutlery, kitchen equipment are provided.
