ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must meet at least one of the following criteria to be considered for admission.

General admissions list of criteria:

- 1 completion of an Australian Senior Secondary Certificate of Education, or its equivalent, at an appropriate level AND
- 2 18 years of age or over OR
- 3 mature-age entry (aged 21 or over) with relevant work experience OR
- 4 successful completion of a relevant Diploma.

Recognition of Prior Learning

If you have relevant formal education or industry experience then you may be eligible for advanced standing towards your chosen degree. Martin Higher Education is committed to individual assessment of prior learning to ensure an ideal student outcome that minimises duplication of learning while ensuring essential course and life skills are obtained.

HOW TO APPLY

Apply directly to Martin Higher Education – visit martindegrees.edu.au. Do not apply through UAC.

ENROLMENT

Enrolment/admissions process:

- submit application and supporting documents
- admissions conduct entry requirement check
- if your application is successful you will receive a letter of offer and acceptance of offer documents
- apply for FEE-HELP at this stage
- confirmation of enrolment sent by Admissions.

Transfer of credit or recognition of prior learning is done as part of the enrolment process. For more information, visit Educational Pathways on our website martin.edu.au/degrees/educational-pathways.

FEES AND CHARGES

Tuition fees are payable per semester and charged per unit. Tuition fees are reviewed annually. Fees for each year are published on the Martin Higher Education website.

Martin Higher Education is an approved higher education provider and is registered with Tertiary Education Quality and Standards Agency, which means eligible students have the opportunity to apply for the Australian Government's FEE-HELP loan scheme – read 'Financial assistance' below. Tuition payment arrangements must be confirmed upon admission to the college.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

Students studying any of our bachelor programs may be eligible to access FEE-HELP, a tuition loans scheme offered by the Australian Government. FEE-HELP allows students to defer the cost of their study and pay it off through the taxation system once they are working full time. Students are eligible for a FEE-HELP loan if they are either an Australian citizen, or hold a permanent humanitarian visa and reside in Australia. STUDENT AND CAMPUS SERVICES
