ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

You will be considered for admission to courses at CATC on the basis of your performance in one or more of the following:

- Australian Year 12 studies
- tertiary or post-secondary qualifications
- overseas qualifications considered equivalent to Australian studies
- one of the alternative entry pathways listed below.

Some courses also have additional selection criteria such as a questionnaire or portfolio. When assessing your application, CATC may take any or all of your qualifications and additional selection criteria into account.

Overseas qualifications

Australian citizens or permanent residents of Australia with overseas qualifications must contact CATC to discuss eligibility for admission before submitting an application to UAC.

If you have secondary or tertiary qualifications from countries where English is not the standard language of instruction, you must provide evidence of English language proficiency – read section 2.9 in Part 1 and visit www.uac.edu.au/undergraduate/admission/elp.shtml.

English language proficiency of IELTS 5.5 (Academic) equivalent, with a minimum of 5.0 in each skill is required.

Alternative entry and pathways

TAFE or equivalent qualification

Applicants may be admitted on the basis of TAFE or equivalent qualifications in related fields of study. Call us to assess eligibility before submitting an application to UAC on 1300 661 111.

Limited ATAR

EDUCATIONAL ACCESS SCHEMES

CATC has an Educational Access Scheme (EAS) to assist applicants whose education has been disadvantaged by circumstances beyond their control for a substantial period of time.

VET FEE-HELP

Domestic students seeking a VET FEE-HELP loan must meet the following additional requirements:

- have completed an Australian senior secondary certificate of education, or
- have undertaken Language, Literacy and Numeracy (LLN) testing and demonstrate competency at exit Level 3 in the Australian Core Skills Framework (ACSF) in both reading and numeracy.
