Notes

- Comparisons of preference numbers between universities must take into account the varying sizes of those universities. For example, a large metropolitan university has a larger cohort than a smaller regional university. - Includes all applicants who apply through UAC, excluding international students, for both 2023 and 2024 admissions.

- Only NSW & ACT universities are included. CQU, Griffith University, La Trobe University, Notre Dame University and some private providers, that process a small number of applications through UAC, are not included. - The preference statistics include preferences to all courses – ie both Commonwealth-supported (CSP) and domestic fee-paying (DFEE) – for Australian students.

- UAC runs a full-year admissions cycle, however, some institutions have elected to only accept preferences for semester one.
